Thank you for entering the **1<sup>st</sup> Annual GRCI Sporting Dog Agility Classic!** This is a first in the country and we're so excited you joined us; 16 out of the 31 Sporting breeds will be represented.

**If you are willing to help set up, the building will be available Friday night from 4:30 – 6:30 PM. You may crate after the work is done.** CSZ will open Saturday/Sunday at 6:30 AM. Parking is available in the CSZ lot and on Laura Lane.

**Volunteers:** We really need everyone to step up. Please consider working outside of your entered jump height. Volunteer sign-up can be found by clicking on the VOLUNTEERS link at [www.agilgold.com](http://www.agilgold.com). Volunteers will receive lunch, drinks, snacks, and special worker coupons.

**Food:** On Saturday, the founder of **Charge Against Cancer** will provide lunch to ALL exhibitors (spouses and kids too).

**Raffle:** The **GRCI** is generously **donating ALL trial proceeds to Charge Against Cancer**, [www.charge-against-cancer.com](http://www.charge-against-cancer.com), a canine cancer research fund at the UW School of Veterinary Medicine. To date, the agility community across the country has raised over \$119,000! To help in the fundraising efforts, a huge raffle and silent auction (50+ items) will be held; exhibitors do not need to be present to win. Drawing will be Sunday at noon.

**High Scoring Dog:** A special award will be presented to the **High Scoring Dog** from each jump height in the Master/Exc Regular and Preferred classes. For the dog to be eligible, the dog must QQ in Saturday's Std and JWW classes and have the fastest combined time in their respective jump height.

**Crating space:** Crates/xpens may be left overnight; however, GRCI and CSZ will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Dogs with space issues must be covered and non-disruptive. Dogs may not be left overnight.

**The Judge and Trial Secretary are Volunteer Measuring Officials (VMO).** *If your dog needs to be measured, please be available at least 1 hour prior to your first run.*

From the North/West:

Take US 12 South towards Madison. Take the Airport Road exit (Exit 250) toward Century Ave/County Hwy M. Turn Right onto Airport Rd. Turn Right onto Laura Lane. Continue to CSZ on Right.

From the South:

I-39N/I-90W. Use the left lane to EXIT 142A to merge onto US-12W/US-18W toward Madison. Continue on US-12W. Take the Airport Road exit (Exit 250) toward Century Ave/County Hwy M. Turn Right onto Airport Rd. Turn Right onto Laura Lane. Continue to CSZ on Right.

From the East:

From Milwaukee take I-94W. Keep left to take WI-30 toward Madison/Janesville. Merge onto US-12W/US-18W toward Madison. Continue US-12W. Take the Airport Road exit (Exit 250) toward Century Ave/County Hwy M. Turn Right onto Airport Rd. Turn Right onto Laura Lane. Continue to CSZ on Right.
