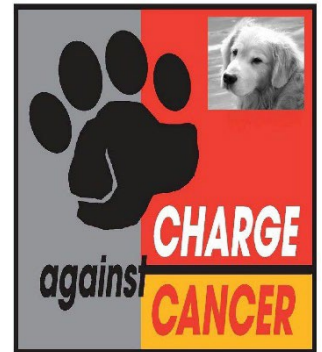

Welcome and thank you for entering the **GRCI Sporting Dog Agility Classic!** We hope you have a fun weekend as this is the **ONLY** trial of its kind in the country, not only because it showcases the sporting breeds, but also raises money for canine cancer research. **100% of the proceeds from this trial will be donated to Charge Against Cancer!**

- ✚ The GRCI is also sponsoring a **raffle and silent auction**; Charge Against Cancer shirts will be on sale, and a donation box will be at the secretary's table. Your donations are crucial in our fight against canine cancer.
- ✚ **Please bring cash or a check as credit cards will not be accepted.**
 - If purchasing raffle tickets or merchandise, checks should be payable to **AgilGold Trial Svcs.**
 - If making a monetary donation to CAC, checks should be payable to **UWF/Charge Against Cancer.**
 - Per UW Foundation rules, only monetary donations to the fund will generate a tax receipt.

Food will not be available on site but there are fast food restaurants nearby. Please bring water for you and the dogs.

Set Up and Crating: We will be setting up for the trial on **Thursday at 3 pm.** We would love your help; however, the **crating room will not be available until 9 pm.** Please conserve your space; place your chair in front of your crate. All crates and x-pens must have a mat or blanket under them to protect the flooring; the top of the crate must be closed; x-pens must have multiple dogs. Please be aware there is reserved space for vendors and club members.

- The ring area will be cooled but only the crating area has A.C. Please bring portable fans. There will be industrial size fans in the ring.
- GRCI, Roma Sports, and AgilGold Trial Svcs will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- Dogs with space issues must be covered and non-disruptive.

Please do not exercise your dogs near the entrances to Roma Sports or on the shrubbery. Anyone caught not picking up after their dog(s) will be asked to leave without a refund. Remember, hotels are considered by the AKC to be part of the trial site, so exhibitors observed not picking up or causing disturbances at the hotels may face AKC sanctions. Please discard your pet waste in the nearby dumpsters.

- ✚ **TRICK DOG TESTING:** Friday/Saturday dependent on judge's availability on a first come-first served basis.
- **VETERAN'S PARADE:** Please join us Sunday at 8 a.m. while we honor our beloved veteran dogs.

Online Trial Information: We will be using **Agility Gate.** To download the app and get directions on its use, please visit <https://agilitygate.com>. The access code for this trial is **1213**.

- ❖ Course Maps – No printed copies of course maps will be provided. Maps will be posted on the window near the ring entrance.

- ❖ Maps for the trial day will be available at www.agilgold.com. Please do not email the secretary wondering where they are. They will be posted as soon as possible 😊

Volunteers: click on the VOLUNTEERS link at the top of www.agilgold.com. The link will be active through Wednesday, 6/17; after that date you will be able to sign up at the trial. **Lunch, snacks, and water will be available to the volunteers.** If you are staying overnight or are local, please consider working the Open and Novice classes.

Measuring Dogs: Please see the secretary if your dog needs to be measured. If you need to be measured and run without being measured first, AKC may remove any legs you have earned. Novice Handlers that require a 1st measurement should arrive at least 45 minutes before your first run.

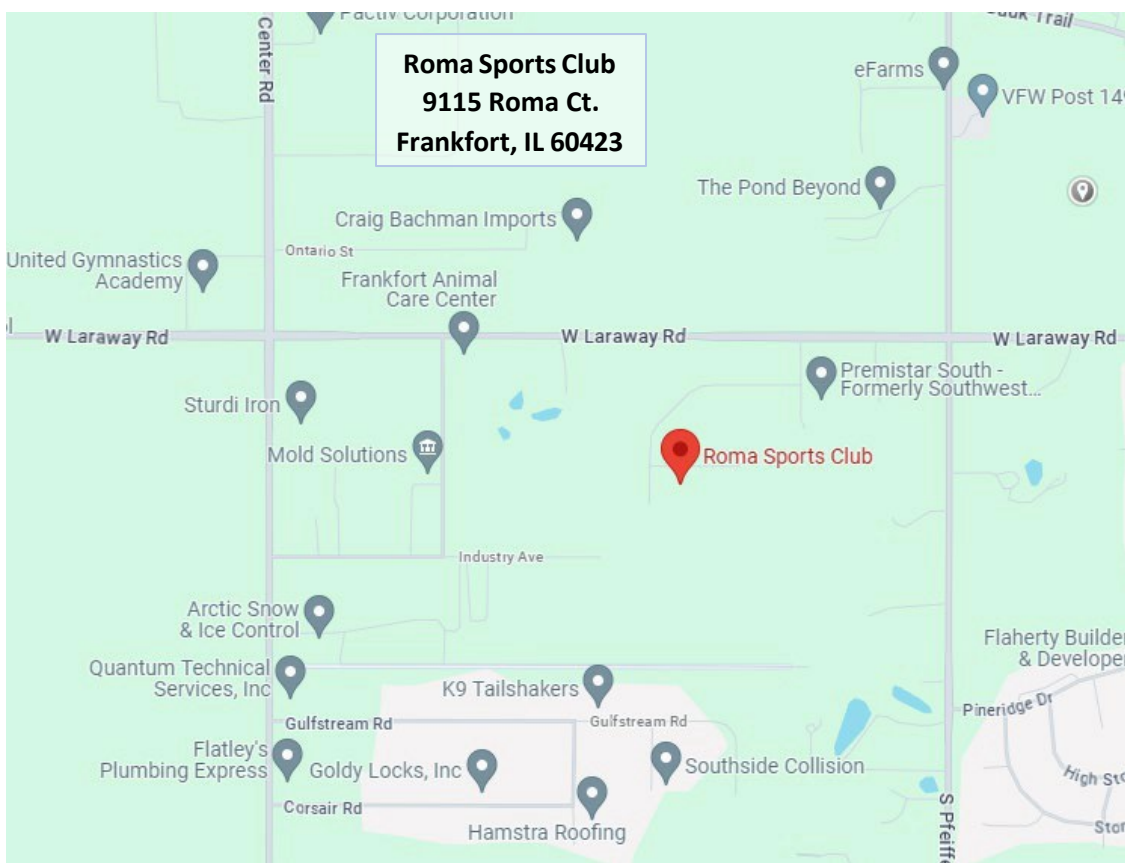
RESULTS/AWARDS

DIRECTIONS:

From the North:
94 East to I-294 South; Use the 2 Right lanes to take Exit 7 to merge onto I-57 South. Take exit 339 for Sauk Trail; turn Left. Continue onto W Laraway Rd. Turn Left onto S Commerce Parkway. Turn Right onto W Fey Drive. Turn Left onto Roma Court. Make a quick Right, then Left into the parking lot. Roma Sports Club will be on the Right.

From Indiana: 65 North to Exit 259A, I-80W/I-94W/US 6W. Keep Left to continue on I-80W. Use the Left lane to take Exit 151A to merge onto I-57 South. Take exit 339 for Sauk Trail; turn Left. Continue onto W Laraway Rd. Turn Left onto S Commerce Parkway. Turn Right onto W Fey Drive. Turn Left onto Roma Court. Make a quick Right, then Left into the parking lot. Roma Sports Club will be on the Right.
