Thank you for entering the **Doberman Pinscher Club of Greater Milwaukee** agility trial! We hope you have a fun weekend.

Parking: Parking is available in the front, side, and rear of Think Pawsitive. No street or overnight parking allowed; no RV parking is available. Please be respectful of Exhibitors working out of their vehicles.

Please do not exercise your dogs near the entrances to Think Pawsitive or on the shrubbery. Anyone caught not picking up after their dog(s) will be asked to leave without a refund. Remember, AKC considers hotels to be part of the trial site, so exhibitors observed not picking up or causing disturbances at the hotels may face AKC sanctions. Please discard your pet waste in the nearby dumpsters.

Food will not be available on site. Please bring water for you and the dogs.

Crating space is available in the back, blue room or the front, tiled room. Please practice social distancing. All crates and x-pens must have a mat or blanket under them to protect the flooring; the top of the crate must be closed. Please be aware there is reserved space for vendors and club members.

- DPCGM, Think Pawsitive, and AgilGold Trial Svcs will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- Dogs with space issues must be covered and non-disruptive.

- ❖ Course Maps – No printed copies of course maps will be provided. Maps will be posted near the secretary table.
- ❖ Maps for the trial day will be available at www.agilgold.com. Please do not email the secretary wondering where they are. They will be posted as soon as possible 😊

Volunteer sign-up: click on the VOLUNTEERS link at www.agilgold.com. The link will be active through Wednesday, 9/21; after that date you will be able to sign up at the trial.

Measuring Dogs: Please see the secretary if your dog needs to be measured. If you need to be measured and run without being measured first, AKC will remove any legs you may have earned. Novice Handlers that require a first measurement should arrive at least 45 minutes before your first run.

Exhibitors will be allowed ringside to observe the competition, but no chairs can be set up in front of the ring. Please remain socially distanced. Unless waiting to compete, no dogs will be allowed ringside or in the bleachers.

RESULTS/AWARDS

- ❖ Results will be displayed on a monitor in front of the secretary's table and posted as a jump height/class is completed.
- ❖ Ribbons & Stickers will be self-serve.
- ❖ Individual results will be emailed Monday morning after the trial.

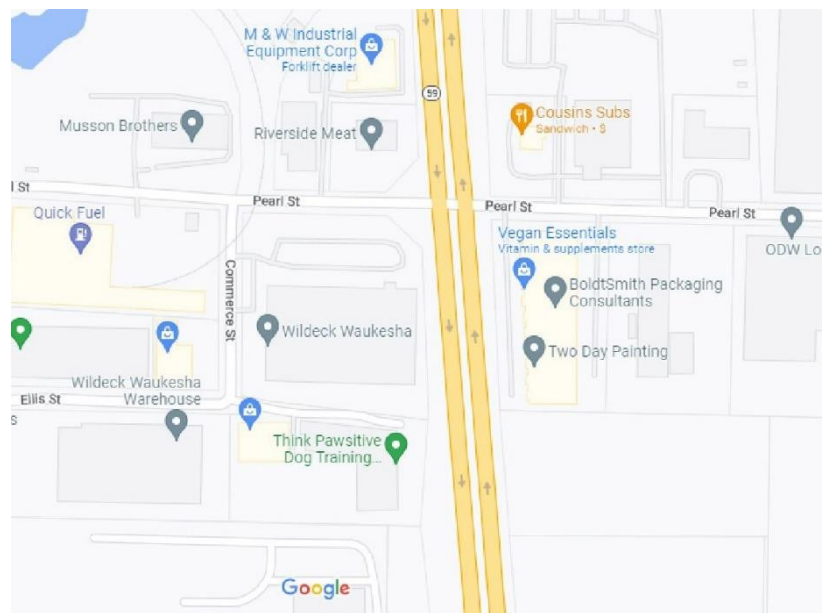
GENERAL INFORMATION

- ❖ Even though the mask mandate has ended, **face masks are highly recommended while inside the building**; the mask may be removed while you run. Please be respectful of others.
- ❖ **If you are ill or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days, or if you or someone in your home has had symptoms in the last 24 hours, STAY HOME!**
- ❖ Clubs, officials, and exhibitors are required to follow state, local, and facility guidelines.
- ❖ Only the Gate, Scribe, and Trial Secretary will be permitted to handle the scribe sheets.
- ❖ The table and timer console will be sanitized after each shift.
- ❖ Please practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines (minimum 6').
- ❖ Wash hands as frequently as possible with soap for a minimum of 20 seconds.
- ❖ Avoid touching and giving treats to dogs that are not your responsibility.
- ❖ Hand sanitizer dispensers will be placed in strategic areas and there is soap in the restrooms.
- ❖ High traffic/touch areas will be cleaned throughout the day.

DIRECTIONS:

From the North:

Take US-41 S toward Milwaukee. Merge onto I-94 W via EXIT 38B toward Madison.

Take Exit 297 for US-18/Barker Rd toward Cty Rd JJ/Bluemound Rd. Keep Left at the fork; follow signs for County Highway Y South/Barker Rd. Continue on N Barker Rd. Slight RIGHT onto WI-59W/W Greenfield Ave. Use any lane to turn LEFT onto WI-164 S/WI-59 W. Turn RIGHT onto Pearl Street. Turn LEFT onto Commerce Street. Turn LEFT at the dead end. There is a large 301 on the building; turn Right for parking in the rear or go straight and up the ramp for parking in front.

From the South: Take I-94 W/US-41N toward MILWAUKEE. Use the two right lanes to take EXIT 317 toward I-43S/894 Bypass/Madison. Continue on I-43 S/I-894 W. Take EXIT 4 for I-43 S/US 45 S toward Beloit. Take EXIT 54 for Racine Ave. Turn RIGHT onto S Racine Ave. Turn RIGHT onto WI-164 N/WI-59 E Les Paul Pkwy. Turn LEFT onto Pearl Street. Turn LEFT onto Commerce Street. Turn LEFT at the dead end. There is a large 301 on the building; turn Right for parking in the rear or go straight and up the ramp for parking in front.

From the West:

Take I-94 E. Take EXIT 297 to merge onto US-18 W/WI-164 S/E Moreland Blvd. Use the two left lanes to turn LEFT onto WI-164 S/Les Paul Pkwy. Turn RIGHT onto Pearl Street. Turn LEFT onto Commerce Street. Turn LEFT at the dead end. There is a large 301 on the building; turn Right for parking in the rear or go straight and up the ramp for parking in front.

Running Order within each height will be: **TALL to SMALL**

Master, Master Preferred, Exc, Exc Preferred, Open, Open Preferred, Novice B, Novice A, then Novice Preferred.

Master/Exc 16 Walk/12-4 Walk/All Run
